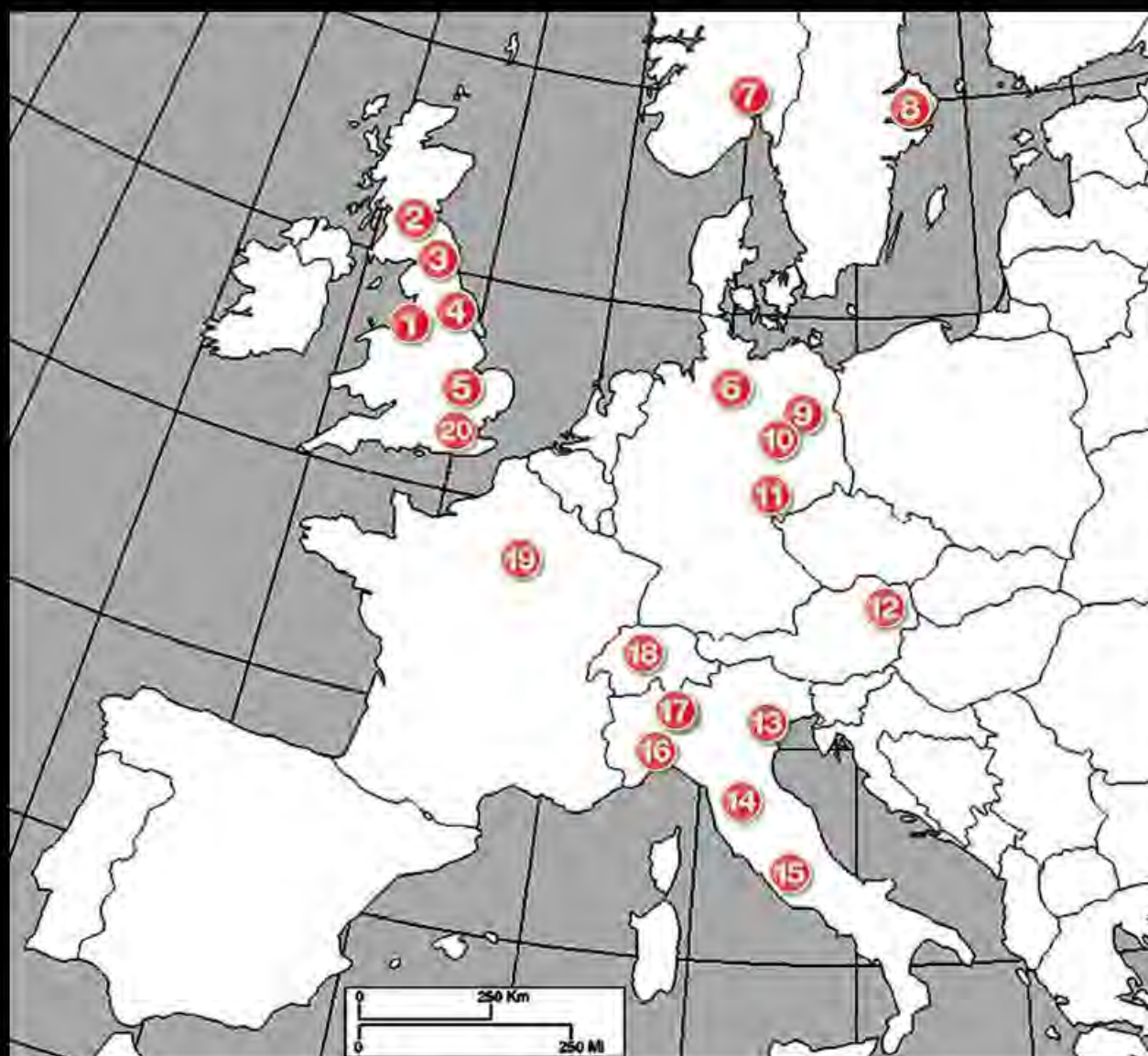

TRAVEL MAP & GRAND TOUR ITINERARY

The four women travelers spent eighty days on their Grand Tour; sixty days and 5288 miles around England, Scandinavia, and Europe, plus nineteen or twenty days and 6612 miles of ocean travel—a total of 11,900 miles.



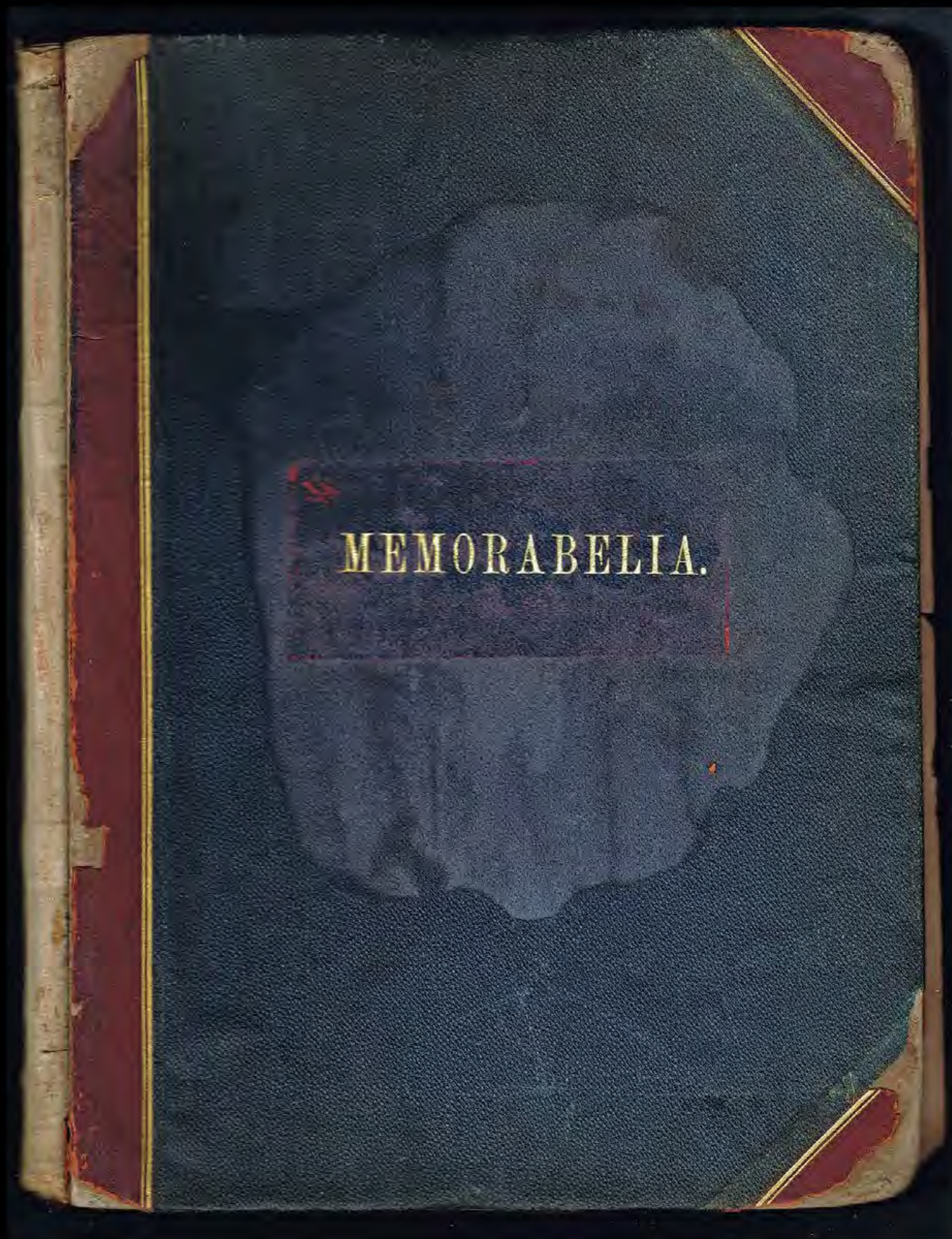
